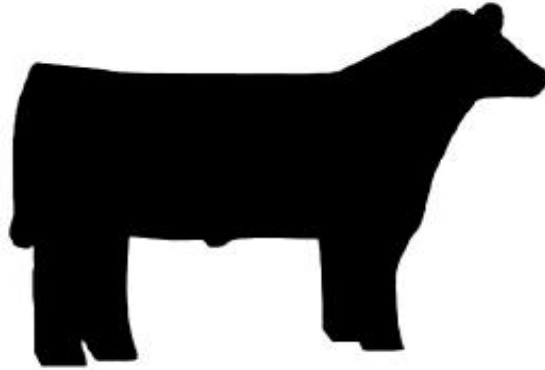

Purpose
